The Gospel Reveals the Reality of Eternity

Luke 16:19-31

The GOSPEL is GOOD NEWS because it is *fair*.

1. Life's Experience Reveals the Need for Fairness (vv 19-21)

a. A RICH MAN

- i. Unnamed
- ii. Position: Clothed in splendor
- iii. Condition: Feasting sumptuously

b. A POOR MAN

- i. Named – *Lazarus*, meaning “whom God helps”
- ii. Position: the rich man's gate
- iii. Condition: destitute
- iv. Desire: crumbs
- v. Comfort: dogs

2. Life's Existence Reveals the Way to Justice (v 22)

- a. Lazarus carried by angels to Abraham's side
- b. The rich man is interred

3. Life in Eternity is the Outworking of Fairness (vv 23-31)

- a. v 23 – *Hades*, Grk. Place of departed dead
- b. vv 24-25 – Place of agony and remembrance
- c. v 26 – Place of impassable separation
- d. vv 27-29 – Place of anxious expectation
- e. vv 30-31 – Place of spiritual understanding



RESPONSIVE READING

LEADER: O Supreme Moving Cause,
May I always be subordinate to Thee,

ALL: be dependent upon Thee,

LEADER: be found in the path where Thou dost walk,

LEADER: O that such a crown should fit the head of such a sinner!
such high advancement be for an unfruitful person!
such joys for so vile a rebel!
Infinite wisdom cast the design of salvation
into the mould of purchase and freedom;

ALL: Let "wrath deserved" be written on the door of hell,
but "the free gift of grace" written on the gate of heaven.

LEADER: I know that my sufferings are the result of my sinning,
but in heaven both shall cease;
Grant me to attain this haven and be done with sailing,
and may the gales of Thy mercy blow me safely into harbour.

ALL: Let Thy love draw me nearer to Thyself,
wean me from sin, mortify me to this world,
and make me ready for my departure hence.
Secure me by Thy grace as I sail across this stormy sea.

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
