THE LORD'S PRAYER

adapted from Matthew 6:5-13 CJB

LEADER: When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites who love to pray standing in the synagogues and on street corners so that people can see them. Yes! I tell you, they have their reward already!

ALL: But you, when you pray, go into your room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret. Your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

LEADER: And when you pray, don't babble on and on like the pagans, who think God will hear them better if they talk a lot.

ALL: Do not be like them, because your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

LEADER: You, therefore, pray like this:

ALL: "Our Father which art in heaven,
Hallowed be Thy name.
Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth,
as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
And lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil:
For thine is the kingdom, and the power,
and the glory forever. Amen."
